SUNDAY OF THE OINTMENT-BEARING WOMEN

In the beginning of His public life, Jesus often went to Galilee where He performed many

miracles. A group of holy women followed Him around, ministering to Him out of their own resources. They even accompanied Him to the foot of the Cross. On the morning of the third day after His death they came to the tomb bearing ointments to embalm His body. Seven of them are known by name: Mary Magdalene, Mary, mother of James and wife of Cleophas, Joanna, the wife of Chusa, a steward to Herod Antipas, Salome, the mother of the sons of Zebedee, Suzanna, and Martha and Mary, the sisters of Lazarus.

Two secret disciples of Christ are also commemorated today: Nicodemus, a leader of the Pharisees who came to visit Jesus at night and believed in Him, as told in the third chapter of the Gospel according to John; and Joseph of Arimathea, a rich and noble citizen of Ramah, or Arimathea. After Christ died he had the courage to claim His body and place it in his own new tomb.
